INTERVIEW WITH BARON!

During this year, all of the Italian TPCS fans got the chance of reading some exclusive interviews that any member of the band did for the TPCS Italian Secret Society fanzine... And now, last but not least, it's Baron turn.

If there's something that strongly fascinates me everytime I talk to any of the guys, is how much they all believe in The Pop Culture Suicides and in the message that this band is delivering. This is what mostly fascinated me about this interview with Baron, too. I am always a little embarrassed when it comes to talk about TPCS music and what's behind it, because I think that it's something you have to experience and not read about. What I have experienced about Baron, is that he is without doubt the best drum TPCS ever had. And I think that's enough...

Which are your musical influences?

Baron: Although it's hard to narrow it down to just a few, the bands that have had the most impact on both my musical direction and general lifestyle would be New Model Army, Killing Joke, New York Dolls, MC5, Bauhaus, Raison D'etre, and Dead Can Dance, although I could easily come up with a list of 50+ bands that have somehow influenced me in some way or another.

Do you remember the first concert you ever went to?

Baron: The first concert I ever attended was in 1989 at a closed down adult movie theater called The Harbor in Detroit, Michigan. The headlining act was M.O.D, with local openers Skraps and Almighty Lumberjacks of Death.

And the first time ever you have been on stage?

Baron: My first time on stage was in 1992 at another cesspool nightclub in Detroit called Blondie's, which was closed down in 1994.

How did you become a member of TPCS?

Baron: I'd seen the band's name around in the months previous to auditioning, but hadn't actually seen the band perform live. When I saw they were looking for a new drummer, I was determined to join the band because I was looking for a unique band that was more than just a basic guitar-rock bar band, and I was impressed by Zim's philosophy and work ethic regarding the band.

What have you felt and thought the first time ever you have played with TPCS?

Baron: The first time I played with TPCS was a pretty uneasy experience on my part, because I'd never actually 'auditioned' for a band comprised of musicians that I didn't already know. Thankfully the whole band was very accommodating, not to mention we all share a deep-rooted love for Cheap Trick.

Name three things you think we should get rid of to make this world a better place.

Baron: Two things: television and organized religion.

This interview is gonna be published on the Italian TPCS fanzine and it's gonna be read not only by your Italian fans, but probably also by people that will find that for chance and probably will hear about the band for the first time in their life... what would you like to tell them to goad them in checking out the band?

Baron: What appealed to me most about TPCS previous to joining the

band was Zim's unorthodox vision and approach to song writing and structuring, which makes it more challenging for both the band and the listener. It's not 'background music'. It demands your attention and rewards repeated listenings, and the songs hit like a 10-ton hammer live, and I've always maintained that the true test of a band is whether they're able to deliver live.
